Meeting Summary

1. The meeting was called to order by Rick Walling at 7:08. There was not a quorum of members, so most agenda items were not addressed (approval of meeting minutes, election of chair, updates, and other business).
2. Rick described to the attending members three conservation projects for which the Ammonoosuc Conservation Trust will be submitting grant applications to the Upper Connecticut River Mitigation and Enhancement Fund (MEF). All three projects involved properties with located near the confluence of the Ammonoosuc and Connecticut Rivers: the Neil Chamberlain property in Bath, the Jean Chamberlain property in Bath, and the Jean Chamberlain property in North Haverhill. The Neil Chamberlain property has frontage on the Connecticut River and the Jean Chamberlain property in Bath has frontage on the Ammonoosuc River. Each project would involve placing a conservation easement on the property and plantings to create or enhance riparian and/or wetland buffers.

Since there was no quorum present, it was agreed that a letter would be drafted to indicate the support of the three members present for the awarding of grant funds from the MEF to support these three projects. The letter will clearly state that it is conveying the support of the three members, but not the subcommittee as a whole.

3. The next meeting will be on April 19th, 2018 at the Littleton Community Center.
