#### Minutes

#### 1. Welcome

Walling starts the meeting. Attendees introduce themselves.

# 2. Meeting Minutes Review from March

Walling opens the March meeting minutes for review. No comments are raised. By motion of Piper/Potashnick, the meeting minutes are approved. The motion passes with one abstention from Potashnick

# 3. Permit Reviews and Communications

a. Electric Transmission Line Maintenance, Littleton, Shoreland Permit

Members agree the work included in this permit is not of concern to the LRS. No action is taken.

b. 100 Bridge St, Lancaster, Standard Dredge and Fill Wetlands Permit (NH permit: 2022-01312) Comments due by 6/9

Description: Replace an existing staircase with a set of over-the-bank stairs and construct a seasonal floating dock equipped with an access ramp and a concrete dock anchoring pad.

Christie explains that the Lancaster Conservation Commission is monitoring this permit. There have been no major concerns raised and all seems to be well done in the application. Christie indicates that he will keep the LRS informed of any updates.

c. 19 Monroe Rd, Littleton, Shoreland Permit (NH permit: 2022-01447) Comments due 6/13

Description: Construct a house, garage, septic system, well and driveway.

Members express some concern about the proximity of the septic system to water considering the slope. Walling offers to contact the applicant directly in order to discuss the concern. Members agree.

d. Various locations, Pesticide application (NH special permit) Comments due by 7/1

Description: applications of pesticides along the upper Connecticut River and some of the tributaries.

No concerns are raised on the application as presented. It is generally preferred to avoid pesticide use, and understand its use in specific situation using best management practices, already highlighted in the application.

e. 859 Dalton Rd, Dalton, Standard Dredge and Fill (NH permit: 2022-01021) Comments were due by 5/19

Description: Install a seasonal dock made of aluminum and wood to run parallel to the shoreline.

No updates on this permit. The opportunity for comment is past and is here for members general awareness.

f. VT General Pesticide Permit. Comments were due by May 31.
